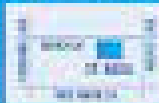

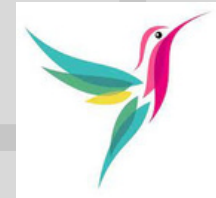

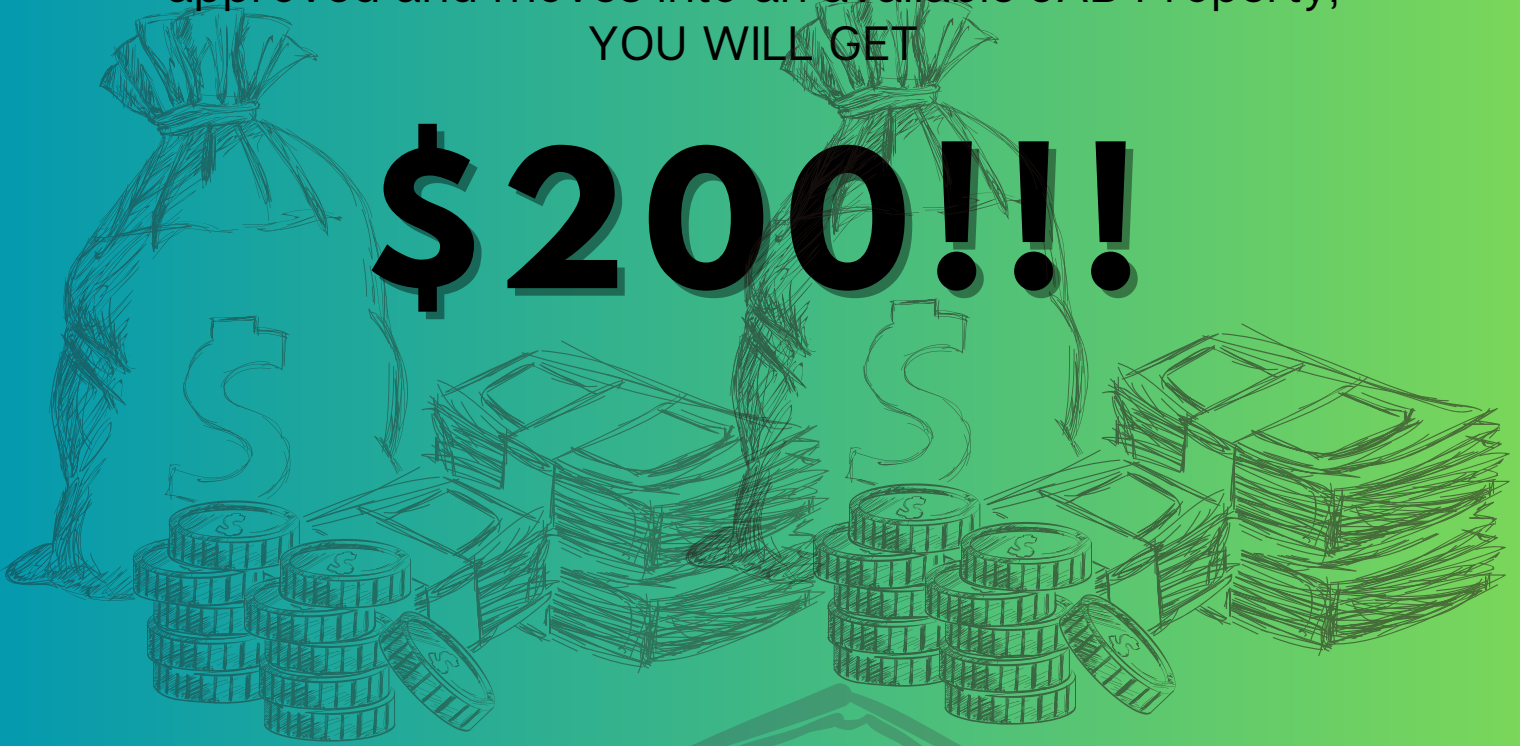

Tenant Q&A

Q: My friend needs a place to stay for a few months. Can they stay with me?

A: No. Your lease states: The leased premises may be occupied solely by Residents. No other persons have permission to occupy the Leased Premises. It is a material breach of this agreement if any person other than Residents or Occupants occupies the Leased Premises for more than fourteen (14) consecutive or 14 total days in any twelve month period and shall entitle Owner to serve Residents with a notice terminating the tenancy.

Q: I need to work on my car, is it ok if I park in someone else's spot to do that?

A: No and No. First of all, as stated in your lease, (P56) auto repairs are not permitted on the premises. NO EXCEPTIONS
Second, residents are assigned a space and no switching or trading or "borrowing" assigned spaces is allowed.
Please park in your designated space only.

Q: Since marijuana is legal in California, that means I can smoke it anywhere I want, right?

A: No Marijuana is still illegal under federal law. When you signed your lease, you agreed not to engage in any criminal activity in or near the leased premises, including the possession, use or cultivation of marijuana. You'll have to get your smoke on elsewhere, because any violation of this law, even a single instance, may lead to immediate termination of your lease.

Q: My mom's coming to visit, is it ok if she brings her little Yorkie?

A: No No animals allowed on the property other than those listed on the rental agreement, so unless your mom's Yorkie is a service dog, she needs to leave it at her house.
